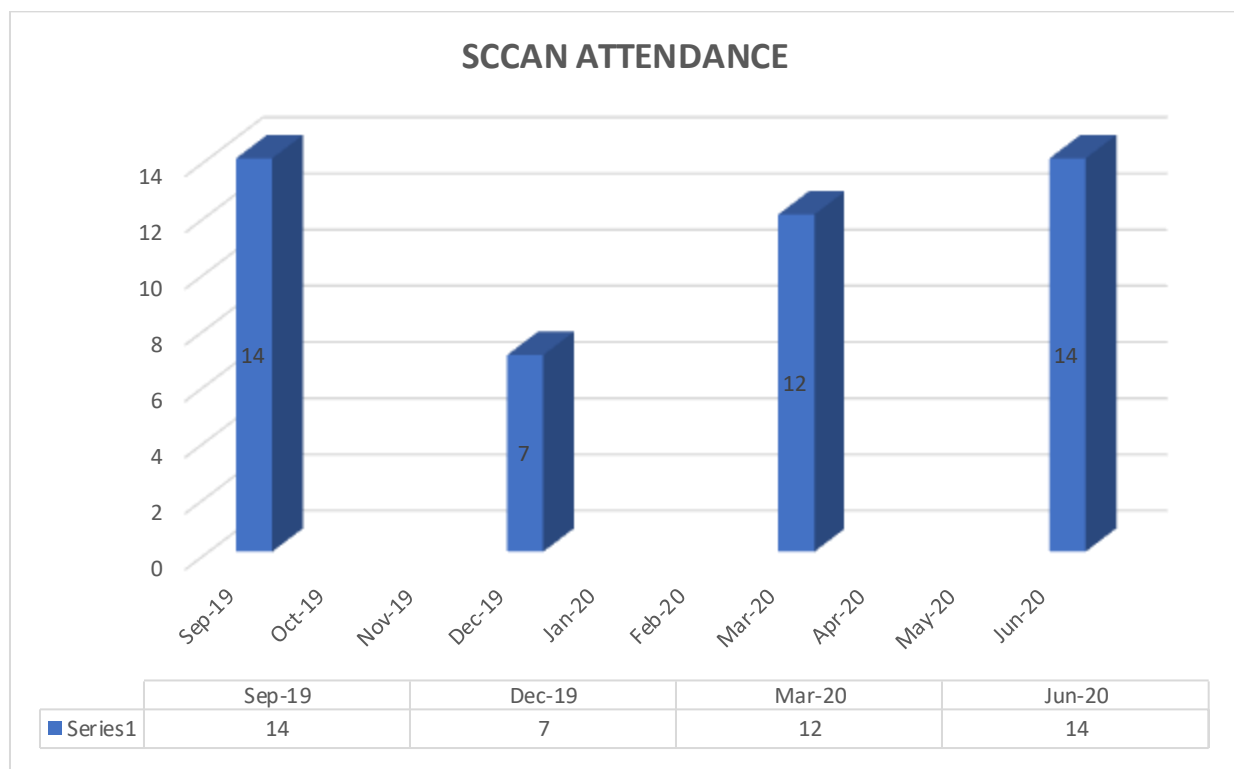

Prior to each N-QI-CAN meeting the Chair e-mails group members to ask if there are any issues they feel should be raised at that meeting, or that they would like added to the agenda for the SCCAN meeting. Feedback from the N-QI-CAN meeting is brought to the SCCAN meeting and discussed.

At each SCCAN meeting there is a presentation from the local NICE Field Team, this includes updates on guidance and resources available, and provides an opportunity to provide feedback to the national team.

Each meeting has time set aside for networking and sharing learning as feedback from members has indicated that this is found valued by members as a useful feature of the meetings.

The SCCAN network have been using a more centralised venue for the last 12 months at a cost of £190 per meeting. Depending on if we can meet face to face we will potentially will spend another £380 on meeting room hire in December and March.



## Challenges

- Wide geographical area covered by network had made attendance low in the past.

## Successes

- We have been using a more centralised venue for the last 12 months and have seen increased attendance.
- First virtual SCAAN held in June 2020 which worked really well and had really good attendance.
- NICE representative sends updates or attends in person each meeting.

## Plans

- October meeting to be held via Teams.
- Plan to hold future meetings via Teams and face to face option.
- Now networks can successfully "meet" virtually is there an option to create networks based on services offered i.e. Acute networks and MH/Community networks.
